Das Fernweh hatte René Burri schon früh gepackt, «weil mein Vater, Küchenchef in grossen Hotels, unglaubliche Delikatessen aus aller Welt nach Hause brachte. Crevetten, Schnecken, Muscheln, exotische Früchte und Gewürze. Damit hat er meinen unruhigen Geist geweckt. Ich roch das Meer und wollte die Orte sehen, wo diese wundersamen Tiere lebten.» 1946, als 13-Jähriger, machte René Burri sein erstes Bild. Sein Vater, ein Hobbyfotograf, hatte ihm eine Kamera in die Hand gedrückt, um Winston Churchills historischen Besuch in Zürich als Foto einzufangen.

René Burri hält die Zeit im Bild fest. Er fotografierte die Länder des sowjetischen Blocks hinter dem Eisernen Vorhang, die Zypernkrise, den Bürgerkrieg im Libanon, den Korea- und den Vietnamkrieg, die Kennedy-Beerdigung, er war in Kuba, Peru, Mexiko, Bolivien, Brasilien, oft im Mittleren Osten, in Japan, China, Indien, Pakistan, Südafrika, hundertmal in Amerika, aber auch in Deutschland, Italien und Frankreich, wo Paris einen ganz speziellen Platz einnimmt, «denn dort hat alles angefangen». Per Autostopp kam er 1955, nach seinem Studium an der Zürcher Kunstgewerbeschule, zum ersten Mal in die Stadt an der Seine, die zu seinem Hafen und seiner Heimat wurde. Seit vielen Jahren lebt er dort mit seiner Frau Clotilde und seinem Sohn Léon Ulysse.

René Burri has photographed lots of the most important people and events of the past 50 years. But this tireless and dedicated photographer is more storyteller than simple reporter, with each of his pictures telling its own tale. His portraits of Che Guevara, Pablo Picasso and Le Corbusier are world-famous.

A desire to see distant places had gripped him early on: "My father worked as a chef in big hotels and used to bring home incredible delicacies from all over the world. Shrimps, snails, mussels, exotic fruits and spices. This all served to stir up my restless spirit. I could smell the ocean and wanted to see the places where these wonderful creatures lived." René Burri took his first picture in 1946 at the age of 13. His father, an amateur photographer, had given him the camera to capture Winston Churchill's historic visit to Zurich on film. René Burri has frozen time in his pictures. He photographed the countries of the old Soviet bloc behind the Iron Curtain, the crisis in Cyprus, civil strife in the Lebanon, both the Korean and Vietnam wars, Kennedy's funeral; he has been to Cuba, Peru, Mexico, Bolivia, Brazil, frequently to the Middle East, to Japan, China, India, Pakistan, South Africa, a hundred times to America, but also to Germany, Italy and France, where Paris enjoys a special place - "because that's where it all began". He first saw Paris in 1955 when he hitch-hiked there after finishing his studies at the Zurich School of Applied Arts. The city on the Seine became his haven and his home. René Burri lives there with his wife Clotilde and their son Léon Ulysse.
























